

Sport Funding for Primary Schools

The additional funding for sport in primary schools is given to help improve the quality of PE provision in schools and to help children to make healthy choices.

It is funded by the Department for Education and for the 2015/16 academic year we received £8,912.

At Bispham Drive we use this money to employ specialist providers of sports and PE teaching through First Grade Coaching Ltd (£6780). The remaining funds (£2312) are to be used to support the upgrade of our playground with playground markings designed to promote active play.

The work that First Grade do gives children access to a wider range of sports coaching and also provides professional development for in-school staff as well as the well-attended before and after school clubs on Tuesday. The funding allows us to provide these free of charge.

Children at Bispham Drive Junior School are encouraged to develop a love for sport, including taking part in local and national tournaments. This in turn helps their fitness and stamina and is a great support to our academic work.
